

Regions of the WATA

The WATA regional distributions have been determined based on State Senate Districts. Although the distributions may look uneven in terms of geographical region, the distributions were made based on population and ease of communication through Senate Districts. In addition, communication will be eased since we can generate email lists through Stenger Governmental Affairs by using addresses when there is an issue directly affecting WATA members of specific Senate Districts.

Since Regional Representatives are now elected by the membership, we needed to have a way to determine which district each person belonged to for voting reasons. Only members of each region will vote for their respective Regional Representative.

- The Northwest Region includes 6 districts:
 - 10, 23, 24, 25, 29, and 31
- The Northeast Region includes 9 districts:
 - 1, 2, 3, 9, 12, 14, 18, 19, and 20
- The Southwest Region includes 8 districts:
 - 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 26, 27, and 32
- The Southeast Region includes 10 districts:
 - 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 21, 22, 28, and 33
